RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GOSHEN ADOPTING THE 2023 WASHINGTON COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Goshen recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the City of Goshen has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as 2023 Washington County Hazard Mitigation Plan update in accordance with federal laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act, as amended; and

WHEREAS, 2023 Washington County Hazard Mitigation Plan update identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in its jurisdiction from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, adoption by the City of Goshen demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the 2023 Washington County Hazard Mitigation Plan update.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOSHEN that:

The City of Goshen adopts the 2023 Washington County Hazard Mitigation Plan update. While content related to the City of Goshen may require revisions to meet the plan approval requirements, changes occurring after adoption will not require the City of Goshen to re-adopt any further iterations of the plan. Subsequent plan updates following the approval period for this

plan will require separate adoption resolutions.
